Guidelines for First Year Students Institutional Account

Students (undergraduate and postgraduate) who register at the University of the Peloponnese, activate their institutional account themselves by sending their registration documents to the Department Secretariat and after the identification of their personal information is completed by the Secretariat staff.

Students go to the address: <u>https://studentaccount.uop.gr</u>

The above website contains:

• detailed instructions for activating the institutional account at the University of the Peloponnese,

• detailed instructions so that the students themselves can manage the institutional account code they have, either by changing it or setting a new one in case of loss.

With the institutional account, students can access:

- electronic services of the University of Peloponnese and
- electronic services of the Ministry of Education

The activation of the institutional account is carried out at: <u>https://uregister.uop.gr</u> by the students themselves.

Password management of the institutional account is carried out at <u>https://mypassword.uop.gr</u> by the students themselves.

Students who face any problems in the operation of their institutional account are invited to go to the address <u>https://studentaccount.uop.gr</u>, fill out and submit a request to the technical support office for student institutional accounts and instructions will be provided to them at the email address they provide in the request form in order to resolve the problem.

Website where you enter with your institutional account and obtain the digital services of office365. The University has procured annual Office365 licenses, you can install the Office applications on up to 5 computers, 5 tablets and mobile phones (more information at: <u>https://di.uop.gr/images/odigiesoffice-365.pdf</u>)

Online Secretariat website where you enter with your institutional account, declare per semester the courses you will attend, obtain information about course grades and request the issue of certificates from the Department.

Website where you log in with your institutional account and follow the courses of the semester you have registered for. It contains Lecturer announcements, course materials, etc.
